What is PROPEL?

PROPEL is your local SLES program and is delivered between Community AccessAbility and EdSpace, in a unique partnership that helps you to achieve your employment goals and ambitions.

What does PROPEL do?

PROPEL supports school leavers to:

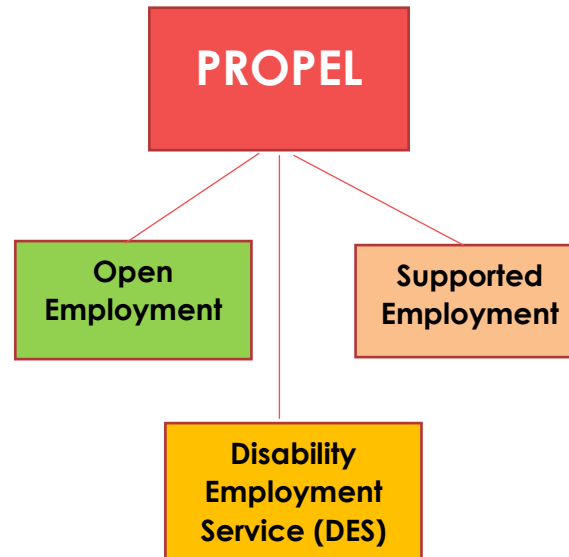
- transition from school to work
- help you decide type of jobs that are right for you
- work with you to develop practical life/job skills

How is it different to school?

With PROPEL:

- You have a say in the content of what is learned
- It is tailor made specifically for each participant
- You are encouraged to participate in a variety of work experience opportunities
